## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION AND CASE CAPTION

Effective Date: August 27, 2019

Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. (“Summit”) filed its application for waivers on July 15, 2019. The Commission Rules from which Summit seeks its waivers, 4 CSR 240-3.235 and 4 CSR 240-3.275, were rescinded effective July 30, and consolidated in Rule 4 CSR 240-40.090 which became effective July 30.

On July 31, Summit filed its *Motion for Leave to Amend Application and Case Caption*, citing the described rule change and requesting leave to amend its Application to reflect that Summit seeks a waiver from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-40.090 and suggesting an amended caption reflecting the new rule citation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) states that parties have ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered. Ten days have elapsed since filing of the joint motion for further extension of time. No party has objected to the request.

The Missouri Public Service Commission finds the request from Summit reasonable and will grant its motion. The Commission is amending the Application and the caption of this action to better reflect the nature of this case. The caption is changed to the caption set out above.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s *Motion for Leave to Amend Application and Case Caption*, filed on July 31, 2019, is granted.
2. This case shall bear the caption set forth on this order.
3. Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc.'s *Application for Waivers Concerning Depreciation Study and Notice* is amended to reflect that Summit seeks a waiver from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-40.090.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
