**ORDER OVERTURNING NORTH AMERICAN
NUMBERING PLAN ADMINISTRATOR'S DECISION**

Issue Date: August 28, 2019

Effective Date: September 7, 2019

On August 15, 2019, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services (Verizon) filed an Application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) to deny Verizon's application for numbering resources to serve Mercy Hospital Jefferson in Festus, Missouri.

On August 23, 2019, the Staff of the Commission filed its Recommendation. No other applications to intervene, requests for hearing, or recommendations have been filed.

Staff explained that Mercy Hospital Jefferson needs 2,000 contiguous DID numbers, ending in an NXX of 7, within the 636 Numbering Plan Area. Verizon does not have the number resources to meet the hospital's needs. Staff believes Verizon has demonstrated a

verifiable need for the additional numbers and has complied with 4 CSR 240-28.016. Staff recommended the Commission grant Verizon's request.

The Commission has the authority to overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from a carrier pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §52.15(g)(5), which states in part, "The state commission also may overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination that the carrier has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies."

Based on Verizon's application and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Verizon has demonstrated a verifiable need for numbering resources and has exhausted all other available remedies. The Commission will overturn NANPA's decision and approve Verizon's request for number resources as described above. Verizon asked for expedited approval of its application to allow the hospital to proceed with its plans, so the Commission will make this order effective in ten days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The North American Numbering Plan Administrator's decision to withhold numbering resources from MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services, is overturned.
2. MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services' request for two thousands-block within the 636 NPA, ending and NXX of 7 in the FSSCRSTLCY rate center, is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on September 7, 2019.

4. This file may be closed on September 8, 2019.

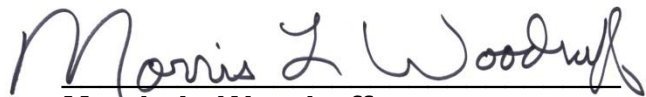
