On September 3, 2019, United Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (the "Company") filed its Application for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") authorizing it to construct solar generation facilities. The Company has requested three CCNs under subsection 1 of Section 393.170, RSMo. The Company seeks authorization to construct solar generating facilities in Missouri near Green City in Sullivan County; near Richwoods in Washington County; and near Utica in Livingston County. The Company's application states each electric generating asset will be paired with battery storage. The Company alleges the battery storage paired with the solar generating asset is not an "asset" as defined in 20 CSR 4240-20.045(1)(A), and so the Company does not seek a CCN for any battery storage components.

The Commission will issue notice and set a deadline for intervention requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this order to the media and members of the General Assembly representing Sullivan, Washington, and Livingston Counties, Missouri.
