**ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Issue Date: September 24, 2024

Effective Date: September 24, 2024

On July 24, 2024,<sup>1</sup> the Commission ordered a procedural schedule setting a four-day evidentiary hearing beginning on October 29 and ending November 1. On September 24, Ameren Missouri filed an *Unopposed Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule* due to a scheduling conflict for two witnesses also called to testify in an evidentiary hearing in an unrelated, non-Commission case on October 29. The *Motion* explains that given the scope of rebuttal testimony filed on September 13, Ameren Missouri anticipates it will take no more than three days to conclude the evidentiary hearing and requests the hearing begin on October 30.

Ameren Missouri represents that it has contacted all other parties and that there is no objection to changing the start date to October 30. Therefore, the Commission will grant Ameren Missouri’s request.

The *Motion* also requests a final day of November 4 or November 5 be reserved for hearing. Due to local public hearings and other conflicts, the Commission will not

reserve November 4 or November 5, 2024 for hearing in this matter. Any request for further hearing dates or changes, if necessary, should be filed for consideration.

Granting Ameren Missouri's motion changes the start date of the evidentiary hearing to October 30, 2024. Accordingly, the Commission is providing notice that the evidentiary hearing in this matter will begin October 30, 2024.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Ameren Missouri's motion to reschedule the first date of the evidentiary hearing to October 30, 2024 is granted.

2. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled to begin October 30, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. The rest of the evidentiary hearing is unchanged, and is scheduled for October 31-November 1, 2024, in room 310 of the Governor Office Building starting at 9:00 a.m. or as ordered by the Regulatory Law Judge. 3. This order is effective when issued.
