**ORDER DIRECTING FILING REGARDING DEMONSTRATIVE EXHIBIT**

On November 12-13, 2020, the Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing in the application of Evergy Metro Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively “Evergy”) for an accounting authority order to govern costs and financial impacts associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. The hearing was conducted by phone and video conference, accessible by Webex.

During the hearing, counsel for Evergy used a presentation, consisting of an eight-page document entitled “Evergy Opening Statement.” The presentation was circulated to the parties and the Commission before the hearing and was displayed in the Webex program during Evergy’s opening statement during the hearing.

To preserve the presentation document in the record, the Commission will direct any objection to admission of the eight-page document to the record as a demonstrative exhibit, to be marked as Exhibit 11. The document is attached to this order.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any objection to admission of the “Evergy Opening Statement” as a demonstrative exhibit and any request for the marking of the exhibit shall be filed no later

than November 23, 2020.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
