
**NOTICE OF DISMISSAL**

**COMES NOW** Edward Travis (Complainant”) and states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) as his *Notice of Dismissal*:

1. After discussions between Complainant and Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”), Complainant and MAWC have reached an agreement that resolves this Complaint.
2. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1) states that a “... complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission.” Prepared testimony has not been filed; nor has oral evidence been offered.
3. In light of the resolution referenced above, Complainant hereby dismisses his Complaint with prejudice.

**WHEREFORE**, Complainant prays the Commission recognize this *Notice of Dismissal*


