**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE LIST OF
ISSUES, ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION, ORDER OF OPENINGS,
LIST OF WITNESSES, AND RECONCILIATION**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Additional Time to File List of Issues, Order of Cross-Examination, Order of Openings, List of Witnesses and Reconciliation* ("motion"), and is addressing other procedural matters as set forth below. On October 9, Staff filed the motion.¹ In the motion, Staff asks to file the document that was due on October 9, for Kansas City Power & Light Company's case, jointly with that document's counterpart for KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's case, which is due on October 11. Staff represents that no party responding to Staff's inquiry opposes the motion. Therefore, the Commission will grant that motion. The Commission will also amend and supplement its procedural orders as follows.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Extension of Time. The *Motion for Additional Time to File List of Issues, Order of Cross-Examination, Order of Openings, List of Witnesses and Reconciliation* is granted. The Commission's staff ("Staff") shall file the list of issues, order of cross-examination, order of openings, and list of witnesses no later than October 11, 2012. No other party shall file a list of issues. Staff shall file the reconciliation no later than 4:30 p.m. on October 11, 2012.

2. Lists of Issues. Staff shall draft the list of issues in co-operation with the other parties. The list of issues shall include any issue for evidentiary hearing in File No. ER-2012-0174, or File No. ER-2012-0175, or both. The list of issues shall set forth issue and sub-issue as follows.

- a. Staff shall set forth any issue by topic and need not phrase any issue in the form of a question.
- b. If the determination of an issue is preliminary to the determination of any other issue, Staff shall list the other issue below the preliminary issue.
- c. Any matter not included in the list of issues shall be presumed to require no determination by the Commission.

3. Sequence of Witnesses and Cross Examination. Each party shall serve upon Staff a list of witnesses to appear on each day of each hearing and the order in which parties propose to call such witnesses. Staff shall compile and file the list with a proposed sequence of cross-examination. No other party shall file a motion proposing the sequence of cross-examination.

4. Reconciliation. The reconciliation shall follow the format employed in *In the Matter of Missouri-American Water Company's Request for Authority to Implement a*

General Rate Increase for Water and Sewer Service Provided in Missouri Service Areas, File No. WR-2011-0337, Staff's Request for Permission to Late File an Updated Reconciliation, filed on February 16, 2012.

5. Exhibits. By separate order, the Commission will assign each party a block of numbers, which each party shall employ in marking its respective exhibits, as set forth in the Commission's order dated April 26, 2012, ordered paragraph 13.b.

6. Effective Date. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
