## ORDER GIVING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR INTERVENTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is giving notice of this action. This action began when Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("applicant") filed a tariff sheet<sup>1</sup> to implement Ameren's fuel and purchased power adjustment for applicant's ninth accumulation period.<sup>2</sup> The Commission is also setting the time to seek intervention for any person who is not already a party to this action.<sup>3</sup>

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall add all persons who were parties in File No. ER-2008-0318 to the service list for this file.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the county commission of each county within applicant's service area.

3. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing applicant's service area and the news media serving applicant's service area.
