## ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

Issue Date: September 27, 2019

Effective Date: September 27, 2019

On September 16, 2019,<sup>1</sup> the Commission received information that called into question the ownership of assets that Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) has sought to acquire. The Commission issued a *Notice of Ex Parte Contact* and directed MAWC and the Commission's Staff to file suggestions on the status of MAWC's *Application and Motion for Waivers*. On September 26, MAWC and the Staff filed responses stating the ownership of the assets that are the subject of MAWC's application are at issue and agreeing the Commission should stay its proceedings. MAWC and the Staff also made requests and suggestions concerning status reports and recommendations. The Commission will stay the proceedings.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. All proceedings in this case are stayed until further order of the Commission.

2. Missouri-American Water Company shall file a status report immediately upon the resolution of the asset ownership issues described in the body of this order or, otherwise, no later than November 1, 2019, and the first day of each month thereafter.

3. The Commission Staff's motion for additional time to file its recommendation is granted. Staff shall file its recommendation on the *Application and Motion for Waivers* no later than thirty days after MAWC files a status report indicating asset ownership issues have been resolved.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.

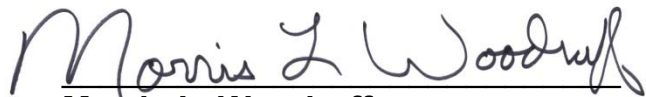
