**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING  
REQUESTS TO INTERVENE AND ESTABLISHING  
TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATIONS**

This order directs that notice of this case be sent to all certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications companies in the state of Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator. The order also establishes dates for the filing of requests to intervene and for the filing of recommendations.

On September 30, 2019, Fidelity Communication Services II, Inc., filed an application and Motion for Expedited Treatment under 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv) requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), to withhold certain numbering resources from Fidelity. The numbering resources Fidelity requested consist of the return of the blocks of numbers to which the Local Routing Numbers (LRN) have been assigned back to Fidelity’s inventory with their respective “A” record codes responsible for default routing. The numbering resources are needed in order to eliminate the routing and rating issues associated with the LRN not residing in Fidelity’s inventory.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will set a time for interventions as directed below. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator.

2. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than October 10, 2019, with:

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the application of Fidelity or shall file a status report indicating when a recommendation will be filed, no later than October 17, 2019.

4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding the application of Fidelity, shall do so no later than October 10, 2019, and shall file its recommendation simultaneously with its application to intervene.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.

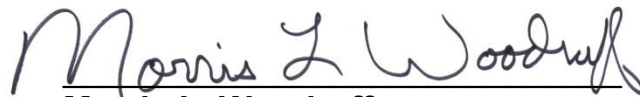
