ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On September 3, 2019,¹ United Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its Application for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) authorizing it to construct solar generation facilities. On September 20, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed an *Application to Intervene*. No party objected to the application, and the Commission will take it unopposed.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240.2.075(3) allows the Commission to grant intervention if the proposed intervenor has an interest different from that of the general public, which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds the applicant meets the standard in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Application to Intervene* filed by Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri is granted.


