24	utility companies in Missouri to ensure that
25	those rates are just and reasonable. The

1	Commission also regulates the quality of
2	service and the safety of operations of
3	investor-owned utilities.

4 Now, the Commission is made up of five 5 commissioners: Commission's Chair, Kayla Hahan, 6 and Commissioners Maida Coleman, Jason Holsman, 7 Glen Kolkmeyer and John Mitchell. The 8 Commissioners are appointed by the Governor to 9 fixed terms and confirmed by the Senate. The Commissioners employ a staff of engineers, 10 11 accountants, attorneys, financial analysts and 12 other specialists in the area of utility 13 regulation.
