ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 4, 2024, the parties filed a pleading which requested the Commission to set a procedural schedule. The Commission finds the proposed schedule reasonable, and will adopt it.

The Commission may delegate any adjudicative authority to the regulatory law judge assigned to this action.¹ To ensure that all discovery disputes are ruled upon expeditiously, the Commission will delegate its authority to the regulatory law judge assigned to this action to rule on discovery disputes raised at the discovery conferences and to rule on all motions to compel discovery.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The regulatory law judge assigned to this action shall have full authority to rule on any discovery dispute, including any motion to compel, and may make any such ruling at a discovery conference.
