# ORDER CANCELING EVIDENTIARY HEARING AND REMAINING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 9, 2024,<sup>1</sup> Liberty Utilities (Midstates Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty filed proposed tariff sheets to increase its annual revenues. On April 10, the Commission set a procedural schedule which included an evidentiary hearing and post-hearing briefing. The evidentiary hearing was scheduled for October 15 to October 22.

On October 9, the Staff of the Commission (Staff), on behalf of all parties,<sup>2</sup> filed a Motion to Suspend the Procedural Schedule and Evidentiary Hearing (Motion). The Motion stated that the parties have reached a settlement on all issues. The Motion requested the Commission to suspend the remaining procedural schedule, including the evidentiary hearing scheduled to begin October 15.

The Commission finds the Motion reasonable and will grant it. The Commission will cancel the scheduled evidentiary hearing and the remaining procedural schedule, and will set a time for submission of a stipulation or a request for an extension of time.
