ORDER SETTING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

On July 19, 2013, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) submitted revised Economic Development Rider (“EDR”) tariffs to the Commission with an August 18, 2013 effective date. On August 9, 2013, the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”) filed a Motion to Suspend Tariffs and Motion for Expedited Treatment. OPC indicated several data request responses were expected from KCP&L and GMO during the last week of August. The Commission granted OPC’s request and suspended GMO’s and KCP&L’s tariffs.

A pre-hearing conference and procedural schedule are necessary to ensure a prompt resolution of any dispute. At the pre-hearing conference, OPC should be prepared to discuss its position on the tariffs in question. The Parties will also be expected to discuss a procedural schedule for the resolution of any unresolved issues.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A pre-hearing conference will be held at 2:00 p.m. on September 11, 2013, at the Commission’s office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required
