On September 3, 2019,<sup>1</sup> Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed its *Application for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to Construct Solar Generation Facilities*. The Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation on Ameren Missouri’s application.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Staff shall file a recommendation on the *Application of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to Construct Three Solar Generation Facilities* no later than November 18, 2019.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
