**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DEADLINE FOR  
INTERVENTION REQUESTS, AND DIRECTING FILING OF  
STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On October 16, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) seeking a variance from its tariff limiting the conversion of LED lights by customer request to 1,000 total per year and 25 per customer per calendar year. The city of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, requested the replacement of over 1,000 street lights, and is willing and able to pay the \$100 fee per light reflected in Ameren Missouri’s tariffs. Ameren also requests a variance from the 60 days’ notice of case filing required under Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice of the application be given to the city of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, local newspapers, and members of the General Assembly representing Cape Girardeau, Missouri. The Commission will set a deadline for interested parties to intervene. The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation with regard to the application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order and the Application to the city council of Cape Girardeau, Missouri.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Cape Girardeau, Missouri and to the media serving Cape Girardeau, Missouri.
3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than November 6, 2019. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the Application may also be made in EFIS.
4. No later than December 16, 2019, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation or a request for additional time, regarding the application of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.


