## ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF ADJUSTED REVENUE REQUIREMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

During the evidentiary hearing of these cases, Spire Missouri, Inc., and the Staff of the Commission reached an agreement with regard to the income tax issue. If approved, that agreement will affect the final recommended revenue requirements of those parties. The Commission would be aided by having the recommended revenue requirement amounts adjusted for the income tax settlement. The Commission will direct Spire Missouri and Staff to submit the adjusted recommended revenue requirements.<sup>1</sup>

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Spire Missouri, Inc., and the Staff of the Commission shall file either jointly or separately their recommended revenue requirements adjusted for the effects of the
