On October 10, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. The motion stated that the parties reached an agreement on all issues and are in the process of reflecting the terms of such agreement in a formal stipulation and agreement. The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant the motion to suspend the procedural schedule. The Commission will cancel the currently set evidentiary hearing and order a status report.
