ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On September 3, 2019,¹ Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed its *Application for Permission and Approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity Authorizing it to Construct Solar Generation Facilities*. On September 3, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Notice and Setting Date for Intervention*. On October 29, Ameren Missouri filed a *Unanimous Proposed Procedural Schedule* suggesting the case be set for oral argument and evidentiary hearing on December 11-12. The Commission will be unable to hear the case on December 11. The Commission will direct all parties to suggest another date for an evidentiary hearing, to be held in December or January.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than November 4, 2019, the parties shall confer and jointly suggest a date for an evidentiary hearing to be held in December 2019 or January 2020.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.

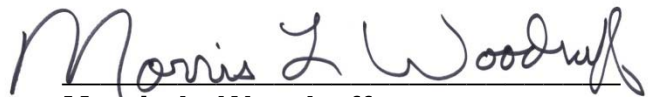
