## ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 11, 2024, Ameren Missouri, the Office of the Public Counsel, Renew Missouri, and Consumers Council of Missouri filed a Joint Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule (Motion). The movants state that they are near a settlement, and further state that they wish the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule that would require briefs by October 16, 2024. Staff and Missouri Energy Consumers' Group do not object.

Natural Resources Defense Council objects, stating that suspending the schedule would deprive it of its opportunity to file a brief.

The Commission finds the Motion reasonable, and will grant it. Any party that wishes to file a brief may still do so, but briefs are not required.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
