AMEREN MISSOURI'S MOTION TO ALLOW SUPPLEMENTAL DIRECT TESTIMONY

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Company" or "Ameren Missouri") and for its motion seeking permission to file Supplemental Direct Testimony, states as follows:

1. Since the filing of its direct case on June 28, 2024, Ameren Missouri has become aware of a change in the Internal Revenue Service's ("IRS") position on the proper calculation of Net Operating Loss Carryforwards ("NOLCs") that needs to be addressed in this case.

2. The calculation needs to be addressed in this case for the reasons more fully set out in the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Mitchell Lansford submitted concurrently herewith. Specifically, the IRS has recently issued three different Private Letter Rulings ("PLRs") that determined NOLCs must be included in a utility's rate base without offset for any payments received through the operation of a Tax Allocation Agreement. The PLRs stated that offsetting NOLCs for such payments is a normalization violation. Because of this ruling, Ameren Missouri finds itself facing an inadvertent normalization violation that if not timely addressed would be detrimental to its customers.

3. Inadvertent normalization violations can be cured without penalty, if the utility takes action to correct the violation at its next available opportunity, which under applicable IRS guidance, is this pending rate case.

4. Accordingly, Ameren Missouri is submitting, along with this motion, Supplemental Direct Testimony from Mitchell Lansford to address the apparent inadvertent normalization violation and the requirement that it be addressed in this case.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests permission to file the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Mitchell Lansford.
