PROTECTIVE ORDER

Issue Date: November 13, 2018 Effective Date: November 13, 2019

On September 3, 2019,¹ Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (the Company) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking an order granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to section 393.170.1, RSMo 2018. The Company seeks three CCNs. The CCNs would authorize Ameren Missouri to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage solar generating assets in Sullivan, Washington, and Livingston counties.

On November 13, the Missouri Department of Conservation (Conservation) filed a motion for protective order seeking protection for certain highly detailed, site-specific information regarding sensitive species and natural community types in Missouri. Conservation ordinarily treats that detailed information as confidential and provides it only if the person seeking the information signs a data-sharing agreement. Conservation seeks leave to designate that information as confidential as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 20 CSR 4240-2.135(4), and to require the completion of a non-disclosure agreement to access information designated "confidential" by Conservation before that information is shared.

On November 13, Conservation filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment asking the Commission to give expedited treatment to its Motion for Protective Order. Therein Conservation counsel stated she had consulted with counsel for all parties and none objected to the requested protective order. The Commission finds Conservation's motion to be reasonable, and it will be granted. The specific extra protections to be afforded to the information designated by Conservation as confidential are described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Information designated by the Missouri Department of Conservation as confidential shall be disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties, to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to persons who complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
