**ORDER SETTING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS
AND DIRECTING NOTICE**

Effective Date: November 15, 2019

On July 3, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted revised tariff sheets designed to implement a general decrease in gross annual electric revenues by approximately \$800,000, exclusive of applicable gross receipts, sales, franchise or occupational fees or taxes. After considering the parties' proposed locations, the Commission has determined it will hold eight local public hearings. The dates and times proposed by the parties were altered due to conflicts with the schedules of the Commission and the hearing locations.

The Commission will direct Ameren Missouri to provide notice of the hearings to its customers using the agreed-upon notice language described by the parties filed on November 8, 2019, with the dates and locations as set out below.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission shall hold local public hearings as follows:

2. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make an informational presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of each local public hearing.

3. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall each prepare a one-page statement outlining their current assessment of the case, and shall bring sufficient copies for distribution at the question-and-answer session that begins each local public hearing.

4. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Commission's Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session.

5. Any other party, at its discretion, may prepare a statement and make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question and answer session.

6. No later than five days before the local public hearings, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall provide individual notice to each of its customers that includes the notice as set out below.

NOTICE OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEARINGS AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS REGARDING PROPOSED RATES

Ameren Missouri has filed tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) that would decrease the company's electric service revenues by approximately \$800,000. The overall request would lower a typical residential customer's bill by approximately 0.03%, translating to an approximately \$0.03 monthly decrease.

Ameren Missouri's rate filing also includes a request to continue its fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") in substantially its current form, which would continue to allow 95% of increases or decreases in net energy costs to be passed through to customers as a separate line item on customers' bills. The overall reduction in base rates proposed by Ameren Missouri in this case is associated with the rebasing of these net energy costs. In this case the reduction in costs due to the rebase of net energy costs is largely offset by net increases in other costs. If the net energy costs had not been rebased in this case, the base rates that would have been proposed by Ameren Missouri in this case would have increased the typical residential customer's bill by 3.7%.

The permanent rate decrease request, which is subject to regulatory approval, would take effect no later than May 30, 2020.

Please note that while Ameren Missouri’s filing suggests to the PSC what Ameren Missouri contends are the appropriate rates to be set as a result of this case, an overall rate increase or an increase for some rate classes could be proposed as the case proceeds which, if approved by the PSC, could result in the rates applicable to one or more rate classes that are higher than those initially requested by Ameren Missouri, or that are higher than those reflected in Ameren Missouri’s current rates.

9. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send a copy of this order to members of the General Assembly and to the media that serve Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's service area.

10. This order shall be effective when issued.


