ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING REQUESTS TO INTERVENE AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING RECOMMENDATIONS

On November 18, 2019, Windstream Missouri, LLC, filed an Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission review and reverse a decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), Samos, Inc., to withhold certain numbering resources from Windstream. The numbering resources Windstream requested consist of Location Routing Numbers (LRNs) NXX codes and thousand number blocks in the Grandin, Oxly, Patterson, Ponder, and Wappapello Park rate centers. The numbering resources are needed to complete the Connect America Fund Phase 2 (CAF2) projects in those rate centers.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed to file a request for intervention or a motion for hearing. Therefore, the Commission will set a time for interventions as directed below. The Commission will also direct its Data Center to send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri. In addition, the Data Center shall send a copy of this order to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, Samos, Inc.

The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation and will establish a date by which any other party wishing to respond must file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THATI

1. The Data Center shall send a copy of this order to each certificated interexchange and basic local exchange telecommunications company in Missouri and to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, Samos, Inc.

2. Any party wishing to intervene or to request a hearing shall do so by filing an appropriate pleading no later than December 2, 2019, with:

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation regarding the application of Windstream or shall file a status report indicating when a recommendation will be filed, no later than December 2, 2019.

4. Any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding the application of Windstream, shall do so no later than December 2, 2019, and shall file its recommendation simultaneously with its application to intervene.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
