## ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPORT

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Issue Date: November 20, 2019 The Empire District Electric Company filed its 2019 Chapter 22 Electric Resource Plan on June 28, 2019.<sup>1</sup> Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-22-080(7) requires Staff to review Empire's Plan and to file a report within 150 days, in this case, by November 25. On November 8, Staff filed a motion asking for an extension of time to file its report.

Staff's motion explains that it has asked Empire to undertake some additional analysis and that analysis will not be ready in time to allow Staff to file its report by November 25. Staff proposes to file a status report by December 13, indicating when it will be able to file its report. Staff's motion represents that Empire does not object to Staff's request for an extension, but does not indicate the position of any other party. The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to Staff's request do so by November 15. No response has been filed.

Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(15) allows the Commission to extend or reduce any of the time periods specified in the rule for good cause shown. The Commission finds that Staff has shown good cause for its request for additional time to file its report, and will grant that motion. Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(8) provides that Public

Counsel and any intervenor may also file a report or comments regarding Empire's Plan within 150 days. The Commission will extend that deadline to match the deadline to be established for Staff's report.

# THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The filing deadlines established for the Commission's Staff by Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(7) and for Public Counsel and other intervenors by Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(8) are extended indefinitely, pending a further order from the Commission.

2. Staff shall file a status report no later than December 13, 2019, indicating when it will be ready to file its report.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
