The Commission will shorten the time for objections or responses to the request of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri) for leave to amend its original application. On November 18, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Continuing Evidentiary Hearing and Amending Procedural Schedule*. The order continued and reset the evidentiary hearing scheduled for December 10 and 12, 2019, to January 7 and 8, 2020. The order also reset the due dates for rebuttal, statutory interpretation, surrebuttal, and cross surrebuttal testimony, the list of issues, and statements of position. Specifically per the order, rebuttal testimony and any filing regarding interpretation of Sections 393.1665 and/or 393.170, RSMo, for the requested CCNs by parties other than Ameren Missouri is due December 6, 2019.

On November 25, 2019, Ameren Missouri filed a Request for Leave to Amend its Original Application and Amended Application (Request for Leave). The original application, filed on September 3, 2019, requested three certificates of convenience and necessity (CCNs), authorizing Ameren Missouri to construct solar generating assets respectively in Sullivan, Washington, and Livingston counties. The Request for Leave

states a fourth CCN is also needed to address the fact that the proposed Livingston asset will be outside Ameren Missouri's certificated area.

No party has filed testimony except for Ameren Missouri, but rebuttal and statutory interpretation as described above are due on December 6. The Commission will shorten the deadline for objecting or responding to Ameren Missouri's Request for Leave.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. All objections and responses to Ameren Missouri's *Request for Leave to Amend Its Original Application and Amended Application* shall be filed no later than 9 a.m. on November 27, 2019.
 - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
