ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND CANCELLING ORAL ARGUMENT AND EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The Commission has ordered a procedural schedule in this case setting deadlines for testimony and briefing and setting the case for oral argument and an evidentiary hearing. On December 18, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Company) filed a Motion to Delay Procedural Schedule. The Company explains that because of concerns raised in the rebuttal testimony, and to allow time for more technical conferences among the parties, it is asking the Commission to delay the remaining schedule until the Company's pending electric rate case (File No. ER-2019-0335) is resolved. After the rate case is resolved, and after consulting with the other parties, the Company will file a request to reestablish the procedural schedule. The Company represents that it has queried all parties and no party objects to the delay. The Commission will suspend the procedural schedule and cancel the oral argument and evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The established procedural schedule and all deadlines set out therein are suspended.

2. The Oral Argument of Parties Regarding Interpretation of Sections 393.1665 and/or 393.170, RSMo, for the Requested CCNs and Evidentiary Hearing scheduled for January 7 and 8, 2020, are cancelled.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
