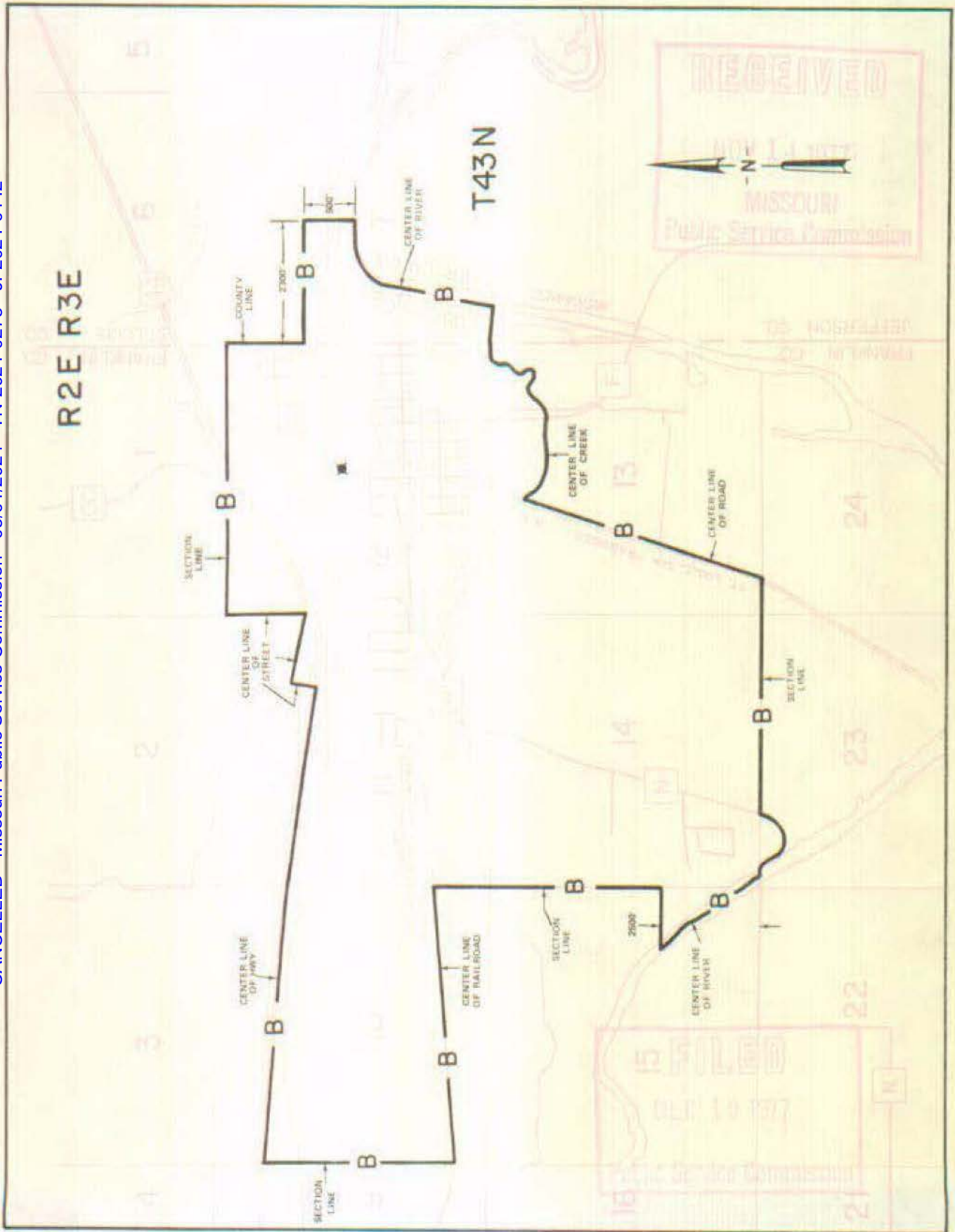

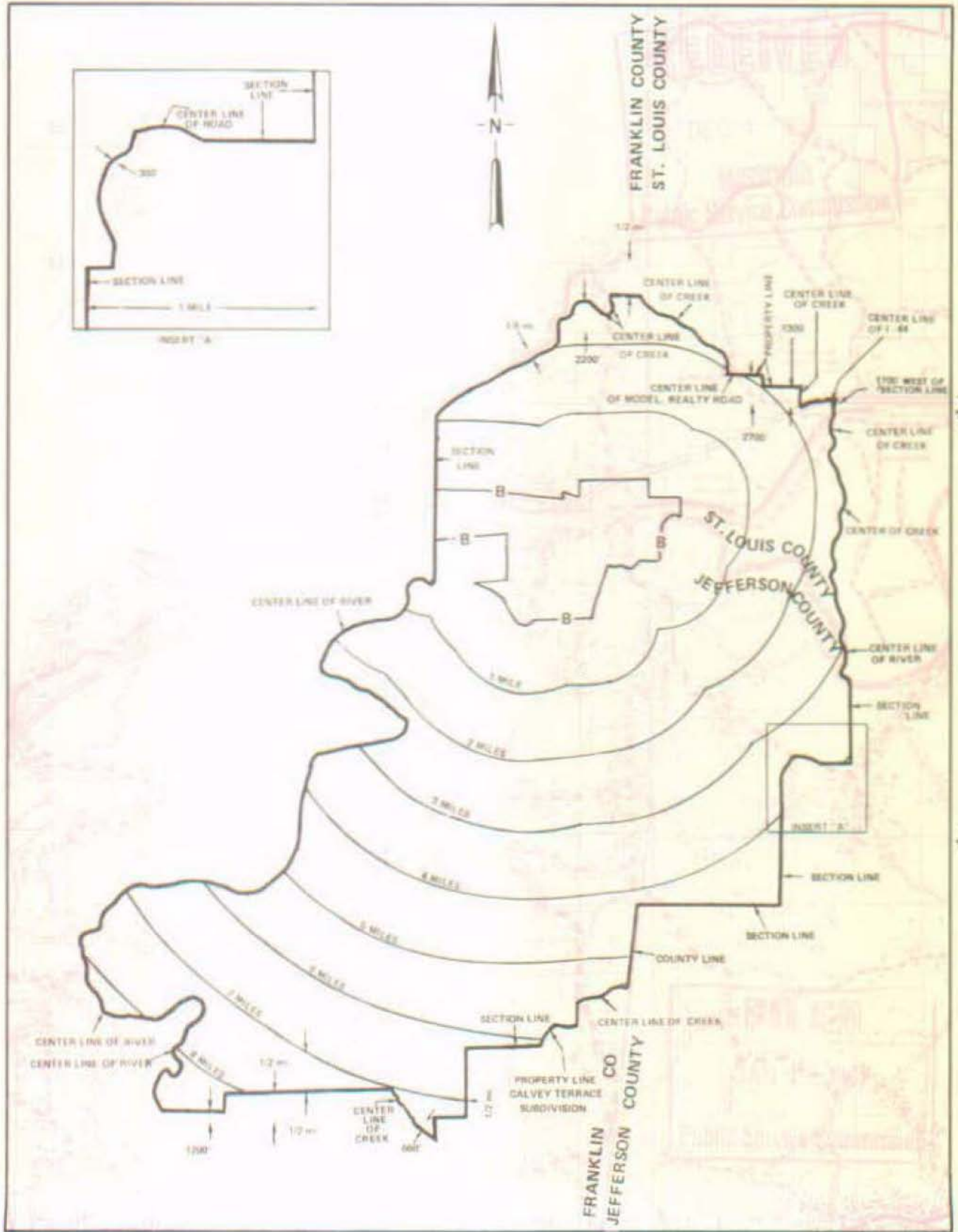

EXCHANGE AREA MAP

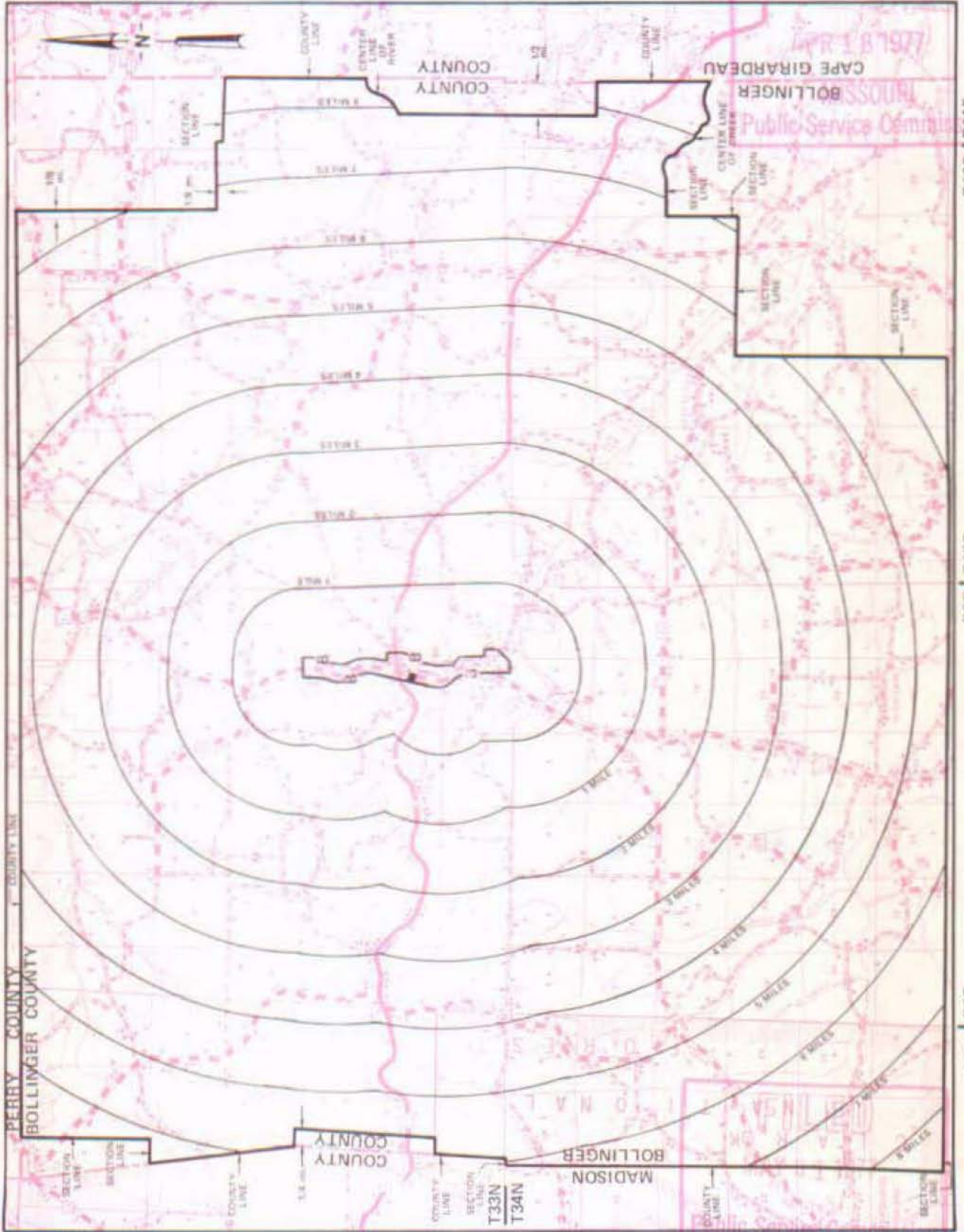

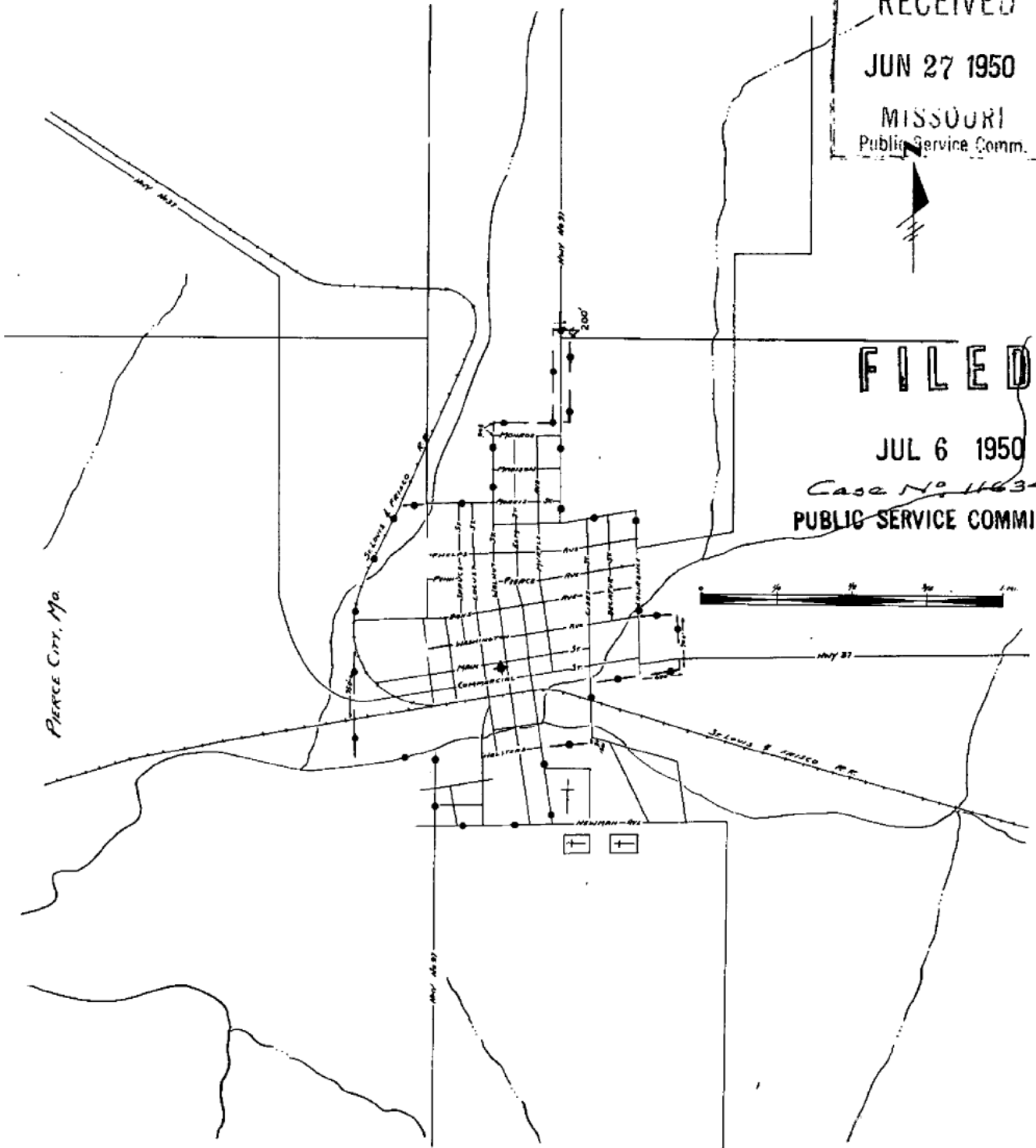
BASE RATE AREA MAP
