ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE COMMENTS

On September 27, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 triennial integrated resource planning (IRP) compliance filing. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(7) provides that the Commission's Staff and other stakeholders are allowed 150 days in which to respond to that IRP filing. In this case, those responses would have been due on March 1, 2021. However, on January 29, 2021, the Commission extended that response date until March 15, 2021.

On March 4, 2021, Sierra Club filed a motion asking that the date for filing responses be further extended until March 31, 2021. The motion explains that the extension is necessary to allow Ameren Missouri additional time to respond to pending discovery requests submitted by Sierra Club. The motion represents that all parties either support, or do not oppose the requested extension. Based on the motion's representation, the Commission will treat the requested extension as unopposed.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(15) allows the Commission to modify the response periods regarding the IRP filing for good cause shown. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown to extend the time to respond.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The reports of Staff and other stakeholders regarding Ameren Missouri's Integrated Resource Plan, previously due on March 15, 2021, shall now be filed no later than March 31, 2021.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
