ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF FILING

On April 15, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Report and RES Compliance Plan for calendar years 2021 through 2023, as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8). The rule requires the Staff of the Commission to review RES compliance reports and plans and file a report of its review with the Commission within 45 days of the date of filing.¹ The rule also allows the Office of the Public Counsel and other interested persons or entities to file comments within the same 45-day period.² Sunday, May 30, 2021, is 45 days from the filing date of April 15, 2021. Because Monday, May 31, 2021, is a holiday, under the Commission's computation of time rule,³ comments on Ameren Missouri's RES Compliance Report and Plan are due no later than June 1, 2021.

The Commission will direct notice of Ameren Missouri's annual RES Compliance Report and Plan, as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(8)(C).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order to each party to Ameren Missouri's current general rate case, File No. ER-2021-0240, and Ameren Missouri's most recently completed general rate case, File No. ER-2019-0335.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide notice of this order to the county commission of each county within Ameren Missouri's service area.
3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing residents of the counties within Ameren Missouri's service area, as well as to the news media serving residents of those counties.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
