ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT TRUE-UP AND APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES

Issue Date: November 14, 2024 Effective Date: December 1, 2024

On October 1, 2024, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty submitted its proposed tariff to implement its Fuel Adjustment Rate (FAR) for the accumulation period ending August 2024 and the recovery period ending May 2025 as required by Section 386.266, RSMo, and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8).

Liberty also submitted an application containing its 30th true-up filing for its Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC), as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(9). Liberty requests that the Commission authorize a true-up adjustment and implement it under its FAC tariff bearing an effective date of December 1, 2024.

FAC true-up

The true-up amount identified in EO-2025-0126 is the result of an under-collection of \$462,330 from customers during Recovery Period 30 (RP30) from December 1, 2023 through May 31, 2024. That true-up amount is included in the Fuel and Purchased Power (FPA) amount in Liberty's Accumulation Period 32 (AP32) adjustment filing in File No. ER-2025-0125, which Liberty filed in compliance with its FAC.

Staff filed its recommendation regarding Liberty's True-up on October 30, 2024, in which it examined the direct testimony of Monica K. Gloodt, her supporting work papers, and the monthly information Liberty provided with its application. Staff recommends the Commission approve Liberty's RP30 true-up filing for inclusion in the changes in Liberty's AP32 adjustment filing in File No. ER-2025-0125.

Based on the Commission's review of the verified filings, the Commission finds that the true-up amount is correct. The Commission will authorize Liberty to include the calculated amount in its next FAC accumulation period as previously described.

FAC tariff

With regard to Liberty's request to approve its FAC tariff, the dollar amount used to calculate the proposed rate schedules for AP32 is \$7,274,445, which includes \$6,313,133¹, the true-up amount for RP30 of \$462,330, and interest for AP32 of \$498,983. Based on an average usage of 1,000 kWh per month, Liberty's requested adjustment would result in a decrease in the bill of a typical residential customer of approximately

¹ This quantity represents 95% of the difference between: a) Liberty's Missouri jurisdiction actual fuel costs plus purchased power costs plus net emissions allowance costs less off-system sales revenue and less renewable energy credits ("REC") revenue, and b) Liberty's Missouri jurisdiction net base energy cost during AP31.

\$4.69 per month.

The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding Liberty's tariff on October 30, 2024. Staff verified that Liberty's actual fuel and purchased power costs match the fuel and purchased power costs included in the company's calculated rates set out in the submitted tariff. Staff also reviewed Liberty's monthly interest rates that are applied to the monthly cumulative over- and under-recovery amounts for AP32, and RP30, and the calculation of the monthly amounts. Staff recommends the Commission approve the FAR tariff to become effective on the December 1, 2024.

Commission rules allow parties ten days to respond to pleadings, unless otherwise ordered. Ten days have elapsed and no party has objected to Staff's recommendations.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8) requires the Commission to issue an order approving or rejecting the company's tariff within 60 days of its filing. If the FAC rate adjustment complies with the Commission's rule, Section 386.266, RSMo, and the FAC mechanism established in the most recent general rate proceeding, the Commission is required to approve the rate adjustment or allow the proposed tariff implementing the adjustment go into effect by operation of law.²

The Commission has reviewed Liberty's verified application, Liberty's tariff filing, and Staff's verified recommendation and memorandum, and finds that the tariff sheet implementing the FAC rate adjustment is in compliance with the Commission's order establishing the FAC and with all applicable statutes and regulations. Therefore, the Commission will approve Liberty's proposed tariff.

Without Commission action, the tariff will become effective by operation of law on December 1, 2024. Additionally, as noted above, the Commission's rule requires an order be issued within 60 days of the tariff filing. Therefore, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The true-up amount for Recovery Period 30 is established for Liberty as an under-collection of \$462,330 from its customers and shall be reflected in the rate adjustment in Commission File No. ER-2025-0125.
- 2. Liberty's tariff filing in File No. ER-2025-0125, assigned Tracking No. JE-2025-0046, is approved to be effective December 1, 2024, as an interim rate adjustment, subject to true-up and prudence reviews. The tariff approved is:

- 3. This order shall become effective on December 1, 2024.
