On November 15, 2024, Liberty Utilities (Missouri Water) LLC d/b/a Liberty filed a joint motion on behalf of the parties to delay the start of the evidentiary hearing in this matter until November 20, 2024. So that the parties may continue their settlement negotiations, the Commission will delay the start time of the evidentiary hearing from November 18, 2024, until November 20, 2024.
