ORDER DIRECTING FILING REGARDING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

On March 2, 2016, the Commission issued a Report and Order that rejected tariff sheets previously filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("Company"), but authorized the Company to file new tariff sheets in compliance with the Report and Order. Since two weeks have elapsed since the Report and Order was issued and the Company has not filed new tariff sheets, the Commission will request that the Company explain when it expects to make that filing so that energy efficiency programs can resume in the Company's service area.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than March 18, 2016, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file a pleading stating when they anticipate filing their compliance tariff sheets in this matter.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
