ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING FILING

On October 22, 2015, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in order to facilitate settlement discussions. The companies state their intention to file a stipulation and agreement or a revised procedural schedule by October 30, 2015. The companies represent that the other parties to this matter either support or do not oppose the motion. The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant the motion and direct the filing of a either a stipulation and agreement or a revised procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted. The procedural schedule in this matter is suspended.

2. Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file either a stipulation and agreement or a joint revised procedural schedule no later than October 30, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
