## ORDER CANCELING IVOIP REGISTRATION

Issue Date: January 2, 2020

Effective Date: January 12, 2020

On December 18, 2019, Fidelity Networks, Inc. filed a letter notifying the Commission that it was canceling its certificate of service authority to provide IVoIP service in the State of Missouri, effective immediately. Fidelity Networks does not have a tariff for IVoIP services. The Commission granted Fidelity Networks a registration of service authority in File No. DA-2018-0194, on January 26, 2018.

The Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding Fidelity Networks' notice on January 2, 2020, indicating the notice complies with Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3) regarding the cancellation of certificates and registrations of service authority. Staff advises the Commission to cancel Fidelity Networks' registration to provide IVoIP service in Missouri.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a registration pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion

or upon application of the person or company affected.” No hearing is required because no party has requested such a hearing.<sup>1</sup>

Based on the company’s request, and Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the registration granted to Fidelity Networks, Inc. shall be canceled.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The registration to provide IVoIP services granted to Fidelity Networks, Inc. in File Number DA-2018-0194, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on January 12, 2020.
3. This file may be closed on January 13, 2020.
