- 1. The Company has had the opportunity to review the proposed amendments to 20 CSR 4240-10.155 Affiliate Transactions Respecting Electrical Corporations, Gas Corporations, Heating Companies, Certain Water Corporations and Certain Sewer Corporations, and submits the following comments;
- 2. To further define limitations of accessibility to the books and records of a covered utility's parent and affiliates, SNGMO recommends the following language, noted in italics below, be added to 20 CSR 4240-10.155(8)(A) Access to Records of Affiliates:
  - (A) To the extent permitted by applicable law and pursuant to established commission discovery procedures, a covered utility shall make available the books and records of its parent and any other affiliates when required in the application of this rule. Access to affiliate books and records shall be limited to information reasonably required to ensure compliance with these rules and shall not extend to information unrelated to the

affiliate's transactions with the covered utility.

3. SNGMO supports further discussion with Staff and other stakeholders around these important affiliate transaction rules.

WHEREFORE, SNGMO respectfully submits its Initial Comments.
