**APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF
THE MISSOURI INDUSTRIAL ENERGY CONSUMERS**

Comes now the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (“MIEC”) and, pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-2.075 and the Commission’s April 13 *Order Directing Notice and Setting Filing Deadline*, files its application to intervene. For its application, the MIEC states as follows:

1. The MIEC is a Missouri nonprofit corporation that represents the interests of industrial customers in matters involving utility issues. Those interests include the interests of large industrial customers of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”).
2. As a representative of large industrial customers of Ameren Missouri, the MIEC’s interest is different than that of the general public and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case.
3. The MIEC does not yet have a position on the issues in this case and reserves the right to take positions on specific issues as this case proceeds.
4. The MIEC’s intervention will serve the public interest by assisting the Commission’s record for decision in this case.

WHEREFORE, the MIEC requests that it be permitted to intervene and be made a party to this case for all purposes.
