A. Yes. I found differences in the generating units, fuel prices, load, amounts and prices of purchased power, capacity contracts used and numerous minor differences.

Q. Will you discuss these differences in this rebuttal testimony?

A. Although the differences described above were numerous, Staff and EDE were able to reach an agreement during the pre-hearing process of this case on the total fuel and purchased power expense. A Stipulation and Agreement is being prepared at this time and has yet to be filed. The Stipulation and Agreement, if concluded and approved, will remove the need to litigate the issues that comprise fuel and purchase power expense. If for any reason the Stipulation and Agreement is not filed or is filed and not accepted by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission), then it will be necessary at some later date to file supplemental rebuttal testimony. If the Commission rejects the Stipulation and Agreement, the parties will attempt to resolve the issues pertaining to fuel expense and purchased power cost. To the extent that these issues cannot be resolved, the parties will need to present them for the Commission's consideration.

- Q. Does this conclude your rebuttal testimony?
- A. Yes, it does.
