## ORDINANCE NO. 8006

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OF THE CITY OF ST. PETERS, MISSOURI TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO SELL AND DELIVER WATER FOR RESALE BETWEEN MISSOURI-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY AND THE CITY OF ST. PETERS, MISSOURI

WHEREAS, the City of St. Peters owns, operates and maintains a public, potable water supply system for the benefit of its residents and the public in general; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. Peters completed a Water Distribution Study which provides an implementable and sustainable strategy to meet the water resource needs through 2030, and in order to accomplish this purpose of furnishing water, the City of St. Peters desires to purchase additional supplies of potable water from Missouri American Water Company; and

WHEREAS, Missouri American Water Company owns and operates a water supply distribution system with additional capacity to supply the City of St. Peters up to five million gallons of water per day; and

WHEREAS, City of St. Peters desires to contract to purchase from Missouri American Water Company, its successors and assigns, and Missouri American Water Company desires to contract with City of St. Peters to sell and deliver to City of St. Peters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. PETERS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Administrator of the City of St. Peters, Missouri, be and he is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and administer, on behalf of said City, an agreement with Missouri American Water Company to sell and deliver to City, subject to the terms, conditions and limitations provided for in the Agreement to Sell and Deliver Water for Resale, in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

## SECTION 2. Savings.

Nothing contained herein shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other Ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in any manner connected with the subject matter hereof, unless expressly set forth herein.

## SECTION 3. Severability.

If any term, condition, or provision of this Ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to

the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the Board of Aldermen that it would have enacted this Ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provision which had been held invalid is no longer valid, said provision shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the City and shall thereafter be binding.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after the date of its final passage and approval.
