- 3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than January 5, 2025. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application may also be made in EFIS.
- 4. No later than January 16, 2025, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Spire's application, or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation.
 - 5. This order shall be effective when issued.
