On December 10, 2024, Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire, filed an application requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage a natural gas distribution system in Cedar County, Missouri as an expansion of its existing certified areas, and requesting a waiver from the notice provisions of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1). The Commission will direct notice of the application be given by the Commission to the news media and the County Commission of Cedar County. The Commission will set a deadline for interested parties to intervene and set a time for a recommendation or status report from the Staff of the Commission (Staff).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order and the application available to the news media in Spire’s service territory.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order and notify the County Commission of Cedar County, Missouri.

3. Any person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than January 5, 2025. The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System ("EFIS") or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the application may also be made in EFIS.

4. No later than January 16, 2025, Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Spire's application, or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
