The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Leave to Reply to Staff's Response to KCP&L's Opposition to Motion to Strike and Reply of KCP&L* ("motion"). Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") filed the motion with KCPL's reply suggestions in opposition to the *Motion to Strike Pre-Filed Testimony and Reject Tariffs of KCPL* ("first motion").¹ KCPL states that, because it alone opposes the first motion, its reply suggestions will be helpful. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.²

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion for Leave to Reply to Staff's Response to KCP&L's Opposition to Motion to Strike and Reply of KCP&L* is granted.
