## ORDER RESOLVING SIXTH TRUE-UP FILING

Issue Date: February 15, 2012 Effective Date: March 1, 2012

On December 22, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed direct testimony and schedules in support of its sixth true-up filing as required by Commission rules 4 CSR 240-3.161(8) and 20.090(5). Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to analyze the information GMO has submitted and to file a recommendation with the Commission not later than 30 days after GMO's filing. Also under the rule, the Commission must within 60 days approve, reject, or suspend GMO's true-up filing.

In its recommendation filed on January 23, 2012, Staff states that the true-up amounts for Recovery Period 6 (billing months September 2010 through August 2011) are over-collections of \$293,135 from customers in the company's MPS rate district and \$146,284 in the company's L&P rate district. The over-recovered amounts for the MPS and L&P rate districts are included in the company's Cost Adjustment Factors in its semi-annual Fuel Adjustment Clause filing in Commission File No. ER-2012-0197. Staff recommends

that the Commission approve GMO's 6<sup>th</sup> true-up filing for Recovery Period 6. Based on the verified recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will approve GMO's request.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The true-up amounts for Recovery Period 6 are established as over-collections by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company of \$293,135 in the MPS rate district and \$146,284 in the company's L&P rate district and shall be reflected in rate adjustment as approved in Commission File No. ER-2012-0197.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on March 1, 2012.
