ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

Issue Date: December 19, 2025 Effective: December 31, 2024

On November 1, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a revised tariff sheet, Tracking No. JE-2025-0061, designed to extend its Voluntary Green/Pure Power pilot program through June 30, 2026. Ameren Missouri stated that the revision was consistent with the stipulation and agreement approved in the rate case. To allow sufficient time to review the tariff sheet, the Commission suspended the tariff sheet for 30 days until December 31, 2024.

Ameren Missouri stated that the stipulation and agreement contemplates the pilot program continuing to be available until customers have been given an opportunity to convert to service under the Ameren Missouri's Community Solar rider. Ameren Missouri further stated that the New Florence solar facility, for which the Commission recently granted a certificate of convenience and necessity in File No. EA-2024-0212, will support Community Solar and is expected to be placed in service sometime during the first half of 2026.

On December 16, 2024, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation that the tariff sheet be allowed to become effective at the end of the suspension period subject to the requirement that any Renewable Energy Credit (REC) purchased and/or retired pursuant

to the Voluntary Green/Pure Power pilot program will not be used for Ameren Missouri's benefit.

The Commission shortened the time for any responses to Staff's recommendation.

No responses were received.

The Commission has reviewed the revised tariff sheet and finds it in compliance with the previously approved stipulation and agreement. The Commission will approve the tariff sheet to become effective on December 31, 2024, subject to Staff's condition. So that the order becomes effective on the tariff effective date, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The revised tariff sheet, Tracking No. JE-2025-0061, is approved to become effective on December 31, 2024.
- 2. Any Renewable Energy Credit (REC) purchased and/or retired pursuant to the Voluntary Green/Pure Power pilot program shall not be used for Ameren Missouri's benefit.
 - 3. This order is effective on December 31, 2024.
 - 4. This case shall close on January 1, 2025.
