Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri has filed an application to transfer certain assets to Bussen Quarries, Inc. Section 393.190.1 RSMo. requires the Missouri Public Service Commission to “send a copy off all information obtained by it as to what impact this transfer will have on the tax revenues of the political subdivisions to the county clerks of each county affected.”

In its application, Ameren Missouri states that “because the value of the assets being sold to Bussen is less than \$10,000, the property and sales impact of the proposed transaction on the City of St. Louis should be negligible.”

The Commission will direct the Data Center of the Commission to send a copy this notice to the Clerk of St. Louis City.
