**APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION**

Comes now Green Hills Area Cellular Telephone Company Incorporated, d/b/a Green Hills Telecommunications Services ("Applicant" or "GHTS"), by its undersigned counsel, and hereby applies pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.420, and 392.430, RSMo 1994, 392.410, 392.450, RSMo Supp. 1997, the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and 4 CSR 240-2.060, for authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri and to classify said service and the company as competitive. In support of its Application, GHTS states as follows:

1. Applicant is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri and is duly authorized to do business in Missouri. A certified copy of Green Hills Area Cellular Telephone Company Incorporated's Articles of Incorporation and Certificate of Incorporation from the Missouri Secretary of State and a copy of the Registration of Fictitious Name for GHTS are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Appendix A. GHTS's principal place of business and mailing address is P.O. Box 227, Breckenridge, MO 64625, and its telephone number is (660) 644-2355.

3. GHTS proposes to provide basic local exchange services to both residence and business customers throughout all the exchanges currently served by GTE Midwest Incorporated ("GTE") and Sprint Missouri, Inc. ("Sprint"). The specific GTE and Sprint exchanges within which GHTS proposes to offer service are listed in that company's Missouri local exchange tariffs, copies of which are attached hereto as Appendix B and which are incorporated herein by reference. GHTS's proposed service areas will follow the exchange boundaries of the stated incumbent local exchange companies ("LECs") and shall be no smaller than an exchange pursuant to Section 392.455, RSMo Supp. 1997. GHTS is not seeking to provide basic local service in any exchanges served by any other incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies at this time but may seek authorization to do so in a subsequent proceeding.

4. GHTS plans to offer basic local telecommunications service through facilities-based arrangements with the above-specified incumbent LECs. GHTS intends to engage in the construction or acquisition of facilities to be used in the provision of basic local exchange services, thereby operating as a facilities based provider of basic local exchange service. If, and as necessary, Applicant will also provide service through the resale of GTE and United local services. Should its Application be granted, GHTS plans to commence offering service upon receiving Commission approval of its necessary resale/interconnection agreements and tariffs. GHTS is currently negotiating an Interconnection Agreement with GTE which the parties plan to submit to the Commission for approval in the near future. GHTS will then negotiate an agreement with Sprint and submit it to the Commission as well. GHTS seeks to offer and provide all forms of basic local telecommunications service to both business and residential customers, including: basic dial tone, exchange access service, optional features, carrier access services, and other telecommunications services currently offered by the incumbent LEC. Initially, GHTS's local Missouri traffic may be routed in part over the network of the underlying incumbent LECs within the exchanges above specified. The quality of service that GHTS's local exchange customers receive will be at least equivalent to that provided by the LEC.

5. GHTS possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1), RSMo Supp. 1997. GHTS's top management has a long and successful history in the telecommunications industry. A description of GHTS's senior management team is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Appendix C.

6. GHTS possesses the necessary financial qualifications to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(l), RSMo Supp. 1997. Green Hills Area Cellular Telephone Company Incorporated is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Green Hills Telephone Corporation. A copy of Green Hills Area Cellular Telephone Company's unaudited December 31, 1997, financial statements showing the financial qualifications of the company is marked Appendix D and attached hereto.

7. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(F), by this Application, GHTS also seeks classification of itself and its new basic local telecommunications service offerings as competitive, with accompanying reduced regulation pursuant to Section 392.361 and 392.420, RSMo 1994. The existing monopoly services of GTE and United will make the basic local markets GHTS seeks to enter sufficiently competitive to make a lesser degree of regulation for GHTS and its proposed services in the public interest, consistent with the legislative policies established by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and the recent revisions to Chapter 392 RSMo. This Commission already has approved numerous applications to provide basic local telecommunications services filed by new market entrants and has classified those new entrants and their services as competitive.

8. GHTS will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service in accordance with Section 392.455(4), RSMo Supp. 1997. GHTS will provide equitable access for all customers in Missouri, without regard to their income or where they might reside, to affordable telecommunications services in GHTS's proposed service areas in accordance with Section 392.455(5), RSMo Supp. 1997.

9. Consistent with Sections 392.450.2(1), (2) and 392.455 (2), RSMo Supp. 1997, GHTS is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards including, but not limited to, quality of service, billing, and tariff filing and maintenance. Pursuant to Section 392.361.5, and consistent with the Commission's past treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, GHTS requests that, at minimum, the following statutes and regulations for GHTS and its basic local exchange service offerings be waived at this time:

10. GHTS further requests a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H). This rule requires that an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, local exchange or basic local exchange service shall include a proposed tariff with a forty-five day effective date. GHTS finds it impossible at this time to develop tariffs to fully comply with this rule since GHTS has not yet received Commission approval of its interconnection agreement with GTE or executed its interconnection agreement with United. At such time as all facts necessary for the development of such tariffs are known to GHTS, it will file said tariffs bearing a thirty-day effective date with the Commission in a matter consistent with what GHTS believes to be recent Commission practice in similar cases.

11. GHTS submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this Application because GHTS's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options, consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Experience with competition in other telecommunications markets, such as long distance, competitive access, and customer premises equipment, demonstrates the benefits that competition can bring to consumers. With competition customers are enjoying increased service options, lower prices, higher quality and greater reliability. This is true not only with respect to the service offerings of new entrants, but also as a result of the response to incumbent local exchange carriers to the introduction of competition. Prompt approval of this Application will expand the availability of innovative, high quality and reliable telecommunications services, and further stimulate economic development, within the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, Applicant Green Hills Telecommunications Services respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service as herein requested, classify Applicant and its proposed services as competitive, and grant waivers of the aforesaid statutes and regulations.



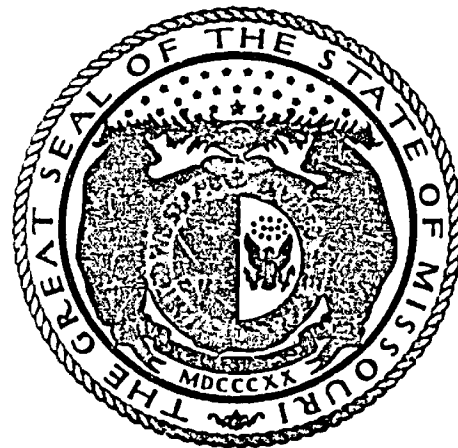

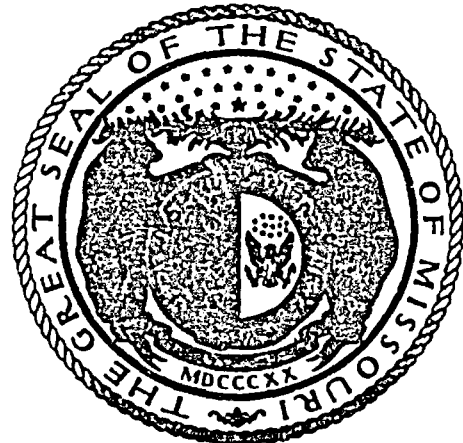

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

A Missouri Corporation

BE IT KNOWN THAT:

We, the undersigned, being natural persons of the age of eighteen (18) years, for the purpose of forming a corporation under "The General and Business Corporation Act of Missouri" hereby adopt the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is:

GREEN HILLS AREA CELLULAR TELEPHONE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The address of its initial Registered Office in the State of Missouri is: P. O. Box 155, Breckenridge, Missouri 64625, and the name of its initial Registered Agent at such address is: James A. Simon.

ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall be authorized to issue shall be Five Hundred Thousand (500,000), which shall be common shares at a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) each.

There are no preferences, qualifications, limitations, restrictions, and no special or relative rights, including convertible rights, in respect to the shares of each class.

ARTICLE IV

There shall be no limitation on the pre-emptive right of a shareholder to acquire additional shares of the corporation stock.

ARTICLE V

The name and place of residence of each incorporator is as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of eleven (11) persons, who shall be elected at the first meeting of shareholders. The property and business of the corporation shall be managed and controlled by the Board of Directors.

Thereafter, the number of directors shall be fixed by, or in the manner provided in the Bylaws. Any changes in the number thereof shall be reported to the Secretary of State within thirty (30) calendar days of such change.

In furtherance of, and not in limitation of, the powers conferred by law, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized to make, alter, amend or repeal the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VII

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE VIII

The corporation is formed for the following purposes:

(a) To provide cellular telephone and telecommunications services and equipment to the general public, in accordance with applicable law;

(b) To purchase, lease, hire or otherwise acquire real and personal property, improved or unimproved, of every kind and description, including franchises, easements, licenses and rights in property of every nature, and to hold, sell, dispose of, convey, mortgage, pledge, manage, lease, operate, develop, contract and to do all things necessary in connection therewith;

(c) To purchase, hold, sell or otherwise transfer shares of its own stock;

(d) To execute deeds, mortgages, deeds of trust, leases, contracts and other types of written instruments; and

(e) To have and to exercise all powers necessary or incident to carry out its corporate purposes; to exercise all other powers permitted by law, and to possess and enjoy all rights and powers which now or at any time hereafter may be granted to or exercised by the corporation of this character.
