We are on the record in 3 JUDGE WICKLIFFE: Case No. TO-98-49, which is the application of the Mid-Missouri Group and the Small Telephone Company 5 Group for a designation as carriers eligible for 6 federal universal service support under the 7 Telecommunications Act of 1996. 8

Some of the parties have asked to be 9 In particular, Southwestern Bell Telephone 10 excused. Company asked to be excused from today's prehearing 11 conference, and their counsel advised me that they 12 will be filing a pleading stating that they have no 13 objection to the designation that's being requested 14 15 and are not requesting an evidentiary hearing.

GTE Midwest asked to be excused and Sprint 16 17 United asked to be excused, although their sister 18 company, Sprint L.P., is here today represented by 19 counsel.

20 At this time I'm going to ask the parties to 21 make their appearances, and other than the Applicants, at the time that counsel makes their appearance, 22 23 please state whether your company is objecting to the 24 designation of these carriers as eligible for USF 25 support and state whether you are requesting an

There are some tariffs that may need to be 8 filed and there were some questions regarding 9 advertising and other issues. I've asked the parties 10 11 when they file this advisory pleading with the Commission that they specifically cite to the sections 12 of the Telecommunication Act of 1996 or to the FCC 13 order or Eighth Circuit orders on which they rely for 14 authority. 15
