#### **ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF COMPLIANCE REPORT**

The Commission has required Cass County Telephone Company (Cass County) to complete a modernization plan in order to comply with Commission orders issued in Case Numbers TO-98-49 (Designation as Eligible for Federal Universal Service Support); TM-95-163 (authority to acquire exchanges); and TO-93-309 (modernization plan pursuant to 4 CSR 240-32.100). On January 13, 1999, the Commission issued an order in Case Numbers TM-95-163 and TO-93-309, granting Cass County's request for an extension of time to complete 1cs modernization plan. That order established September 30, 1999 as the deadline for completion of the modernization plan. That deadline has now passed and nothing has been filed to indicate whether or not Cass County has completed its modernization plan.

#### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That no later than October 27, 1999, Cass County Telephone Company shall file a report advising the Commission as to whether or not it has completed the modernization plan required by the Commission in this case.

2. That this order shall become effective on October 18, 1999.
