ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On October 14, 2010, Robert Wagner filed a Motion to Compel Discovery. Staff and KCP&L have responded.

Mr. Wagner states that “access to the particular data marked as confidential . . . is a surmountable issue.” KCP&L states that “there is no pending discovery issue . . . as Mr. Wagner has indicated that he can obtain the confidential document from the vendor.”

The Commission will order KCP&L to state why the document in question is considered confidential and why it should not be made public in light of its availability to Mr. Wagner via a vendor.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, shall respond as ordered above no later than November 3, 2010.

2. Any other party that wishes to respond shall do so no later than November 3, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
